



**RECOMMENDED LANGUAGE FOR  
MOTION FOR DISCOVERY OF AUDIO & VIDEO EVIDENCE**

*(When dealing with audio/video evidence which has been preserved and examined by law enforcement, industry standards recommend that a full report and copy of the original file and proprietary file viewer be obtained.)*

1. All reports including search warrants and reports detailing the seizure and the chain of custody of the audio/video evidence.
2. The examiner's report detailing tools and procedures used in any analysis processes.
3. A copy of the evidence in the native (original) format along with any proprietary file viewer used for the playback of the original.
4. A copy of any original audio/video evidence converted for playback using standard devices. (i.e.: .AVI,.WAV)
5. A copy of the enhanced or otherwise edited audio/video in a standard format such as .AVI or .WAV.
